



RULES AND REGULATIONS

- **Winning team is based on most points. (2 coyote, 3 bobcat)**
- Must be called Coyote or Bobcat
- Tie goes to heaviest coyote
- Hunt boundaries: Official Oklahoma State lines
- Teams must hunt within 200 yards at ALL times. (one team member can drop-off)
- No road or vehicle hunting of any kind
- No trapping or any other methods that don't involve calling live animals
- No hunting with live decoy animals
- No hunting over bait
- No baiting or feeding of coyotes or bobcats over a period of time with the intent to increase your chances of shooting larger animals for contests.
- No hunting in preserves, ranches or ranges where any fence is employed to keep animals inside
- No pooling of animals or working with other teams
- No manipulating of animals before check-in. Any animal that appears to have been tampered with will be investigated and team will be disqualified if anything is determined.
- Hunting hours are 30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset
- Teams must always follow all Oklahoma Department of Wildlife rules and regulations
- Teams must complete their Predator Tracking log and return it.
- Lie detector test required for winning teams*
- Random Draw will determine who takes the lie detector
- No use of alcohol or drugs any time during or after the hunt
- If you are late checking in Saturday night or Sunday at check-in you are disqualified**

* – One (1) lie detector test included for each applicable team by Cast & Bang. In the event the team's test is inconclusive, the team will have the option to retest another team member, however the team must pay, in cash, for the second test before it is administered (approx. \$200). In the event the team's test fails; the team is disqualified from the tournament. Team members will be randomly selected and if that team member refuses to take the lie detector test that team is disqualified. Pass/Fail determination by Lie Detector examiner in conjunction with Cast & Bang is final and any attempts to dispute results will result in immediate forfeiture of all fees and proceeds of any kind by the disqualified team or its members.

** – Saturday check-in text and photo must be sent by 7:20 pm. Any team that fails to text their Saturday results before that time are disqualified. Check-in ends on Sunday is at 12:30 PM CST February 24, 2019. Each team must be ON SITE at Cabela's by the cutoff or they are disqualified from checking in any animals. All team members must be present at check-in.

Harvest Procedures

1. Saturday and Sunday morning call (405) 633-3122 to find out what card to begin with.
2. After each predator harvested write your team number on the appropriate playing card and zip tie the card into the mouth of the animal, so that the team number is visible.
3. Take a photo of the animal tagged and text your team number and the photo to **(405) 633-3122**. Once you've texted your team number the first time you will not need to text it again.
4. Complete the information on your tracking log sheet, to include time, sex, and county.

Saturday Night Check-In Procedures

Time: 7:20 pm

Display all your animals from the day with cards visible and take a photo of them with at least one team member in the photo. (Smile, you're having fun)

Text the photo, coyote count, and bobcat count to **(405) 633-3122** BEFORE 7:20 PM. If you do not have service please call the number to check-in.

Sunday Check-In Procedures

Location: Cabela's located at 1200 W Memorial Rd, Oklahoma City, OK 73114

Time: 12:30 pm

If there is a line, Cast & Bang will monitor the end to determine who made the cutoff in time.

***You are responsible for identifying the Big Dog and Big Cat before arriving at check-in.
WE WILL ONLY WEIGH ONE COYOTE AND ONE BOBCAT.***

When checking-in present the Cast & Bang representative with your tracking log sheet completed and signed by all team members and each team members driver's license for verification.



After your team has checked in pull forward to have all animals temp checked by a biologist and inspected by our fur-buyer. Game wardens will be onsite to tag bobcats and fur buyer will be on-site to purchase any bobcats or coyotes. Once inspection is complete pull around to the unloading area if you are not wanting to keep your animals. After check-in we encourage you to visit Cabela's store to take advantage of their generosity, warm yourself by the fire, shop around, and hang out with fellow hunters. Dos Gringos Cabana will be setup in the parking lot for lunch with some delicious options for you to choose from.
